## ACADEMICS

- Spring break March 29-April 6.
- April 11 is the last day of the quarter. Grades will be sent home with students.
- **WASL testing** April 15-16 (math) and April 17-18 (science). For those not taking the WASL, school begins at 10:30AM. All classes will run on an altered schedule on testing days. The buses will run on the regular schedule, so those not taking the WASL and planning to come in time for the 10:30AM start will need to provide their own transportation. One classroom (708) and the library will be open for quiet study if students arrive before classes begin at 10:30. The WASL is required for all sophomores. Juniors and seniors who need to take one or more portions of the test have been automatically registered. Freshmen students may take any portion of the WASL (except science) but needed to pre-register with the state ahead of time. If a sophomore misses any part of a test, he or she will need to retake that test in August or next year. In other words, there are no test make-up days. Test-takers should bring a #2 pencil, snack, water bottle, and reading material in case they finish prior to the end of the testing period. The cafeteria will be open for breakfast as usual and will sell snacks that students may purchase ahead of time. A list of rooms where students are to report to test will be posted around campus a few days before testing begins.
