Senior Yearbooks

Did you know that it can cost anywhere between \$125 and \$400 a year to fully participate in High School? This includes ASB, classroom fees and field trips. The costs go much higher when you start adding in dance and play tickets, sports, cheer, flags, drill or any of the other many clubs and activities Shorewood has to offer. For Seniors, the price tag can more than double with the cost of cap & gown, prom, Senior Spree, and more. The Shorewood Experience was a fundraising avenue started by the Shorewood PTSA to help students who cannot afford these expenses gain access to some of the things we think are an important part of their overall experience. When students feel like they are PART of their HS communities, they are more likely to graduate.

As we support these students throughout their HS careers, we also want to support their having a way to remember their HS careers at Shorewood with a yearbook. Yearbooks cost \$60, a prohibitive price tag for many of our students. This year the need has grown. We are hoping to raise \$2,000 (that's just 33 yearbooks) to buy yearbooks for Seniors who qualify for free & reduced lunch.
